Background

Participants in Vintage Events demonstrate their equipment from the past and preserve it for the future history of our sport.

Recently, the concept of “Weight Adjusted Time Trial Events” for Vintage Karts of different eras has been put forward in some Supplementary Regulations for Vintage Karting events. This clarification addresses this matter.

Extracts Of Rules - Class Rules Chapter 20

1 Preamble

- a) The Class of Vintage Karting is to preserve, promote, monitor, co-ordinate and regulate vintage and historic Karting and its related activity.
- b) A Vintage Kart is as defined in these Rules.
- c) Racing of Vintage Karts is strictly forbidden.

6 Vintage

- a) The following types of event may be conducted for Vintage Karts as a component of any Event or as individual components of a stand-alone Vintage Karting Event:

(iv) Time Trial

An Event in which a Competitor is timed for two (2) laps.

- Each Competitor will complete one (1) warm-up lap immediately followed by two (2) timed laps and one (1) cool down lap.
- All normal Officials and services required for Competition in accordance with these Rules must be provided;
- The maximum number of karts on the Track at any one time will be two (2).

Clarification

The Vintage Committee does not classify Vintage Kart drivers by height, weight, age, sex or ability. It classifies Vintage Karts into the relevant ERA's and class structure from that ERA as raced in Australia. The Vintage Karting Class Rules reflect this position.

The Time Trial is included in the Class Rules to provide the Vintage Karter with a forum to demonstrate their kart's performance in a spirited, safe and fun controlled manor and is not intended as a high level graded competition.

“Weight Adjusted Time Trial Events” for Vintage Karts of different eras are beyond the scope of the Vintage Karting Class Rules and accordingly are not permitted to be conducted.
