

COVID-19 VIRUS - MESSAGE TO VICTORIAN CLUBS AND KARTING VICTORIA

26 May 2020

Good Afternoon Everyone,

Yesterday, the Victorian Government announced a \$40 million Community Sport Sector Short-term Survival Package to provide grants to support the operational viability of community sport and active recreation organisations impacted by the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.

The program model will be delivered through two streams:

- Stream 1 State-wide Operational Sustainability (State Association) and
- Stream 2 Grassroots Operational Support (Clubs)

This restart package includes grants of up to \$200,000 for Small and Medium State Sporting Organisations (Karting Victoria) and up to \$1,000 each for Community organisations delivering sport and active recreation (Your Club).

Applications for the Community Sport Sector Short-term Survival Package opened YESTERDAY, and we urge you to get your application in on behalf of your Club as soon as possible.

For the State Association, the funding can provide support for the operational sustainability over the period 1 March 2020 to 31 August 2020 and planning and preparation of a Return to Play (Race) Plan.

For Clubs, the grant will be provided to assist the organisation remain operational during the eligibility period, and to support readiness to return-to-play in adherence with Victorian Chief Health Officer restrictions and advice.

Funding can be used for fixed costs (e.g. rent/utilities/insurance), essential salary costs (not match/player/coach payments) and any other costs that keep the club viable and ready to function once restrictions ease.

Also contained in this document is a summary of the various financial support mechanisms that may apply to your Club. Applications close on 15 June 2020, or until the funding allocation is exhausted.

Please note that if all funds have been committed, the closing date will occur earlier, so apply today!

The Government has also confirmed what the easing of restrictions are likely to look like for sport in Victoria for the next month.

- **Stage 1: (current)** Groups of 10. Multiple groups are permitted at the same venue provided physical distancing can be maintained.
- Stage 2: (from 11:59pm, 31 May) Up to 20 people can participate in outdoor group sport and exercise activities, provided you can keep your distance (at least 1.5 metres apart) and they are not competitive.

This is largely in line with our expectations and our own Road Out Of Lockdown. We will continue to advise you if there is any change to the above schedule for our sport.
