Good News For Victorian Clubs

Also attached are the latest Victorian Health Officer "Restricted Activities Directions (No.7)" that were issued over night that provide clarity as to what the situation is in Victoria. What I believe to be the most relevant provisions are highlighted but I would advise the Victorian Clubs to read the Directions carefully.

Importantly the specific restriction on "go-kart tracks" that were contained in Direction No. 6 has been removed.

Direction Number 7 still restricts the outdoor physical recreation facilities but subject to subclause (6) of the Directions which reads:

"(6) Despite subclause (1), a person who owns, controls or operates an outdoor facility that is used for outdoor sport and recreation may operate that facility for the purposes of outdoor sport and recreation, however must not permit use of the indoor facilities, other than toilet facilities."

This means that the paddock, pits, out grid, in grid and race track can be used but no other buildings (at least until the end of May when the direction will be re-issued or withdrawn.)

The broader implications for Victorian Clubs will be discussed in the Webinar for Victorian Clubs that is scheduled for tomorrow night.

At this stage there do not appear to be any changed NSW Directions that are available.
