- Targeted to increase the number of women and girls who are active participants in karting both on and off the Track



Why Is The Women In Karting Commission Necessary?

- To reinforce the pivotal roles that women and girls have in karting.
- To highlight that karting is open and welcoming to all women and girls - whether as competitors, officials, mechanics, administrators, committee members or volunteers.
- To ensure that there are real opportunities for women and girls in karting and other forms of motorsport
- To promote and facilitate women and girls karting activity at all Competition levels
- To support current women and girl competitors and identify young talent

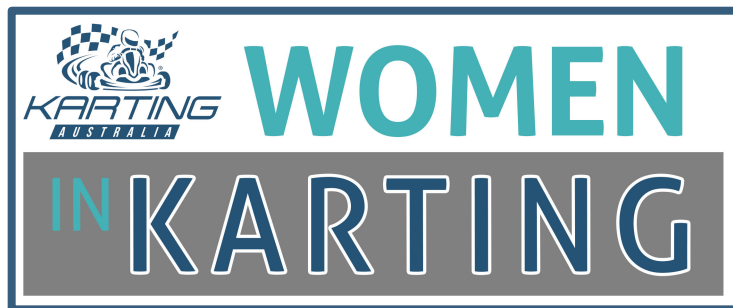


KEY OBJECTIVES

- To increase awareness that karting is a sport that values and encourages the participation of women and girls - on and off the Track.
- To increase the number of women and girls who race in the sport of karting in Australia.
- To increase the number of women and girls who officiate at karting events in Australia.
- To increase the number of women and girls who serve as administrators of the sport at Club, State and National Levels.

CREATIVE ACTIONS

- To create a culture within the sport of karting that encourages and develops the active participation of women in all aspects of the sport.
- The Commission will collaborate with the Karting Australia Board and Management to create and implement strategies and policies that will encourage women and girls of all ages to become active participants in the sport of karting.
- The Commission will develop a Women in Karting strategic plan with actions for inclusion in the Karting Australia Strategic Plan that is designed to achieve its objectives.
- To promote the education and training of women in Australian karting
- The Commission will collaborate with Karting Australia's Board and Management, on joint sports projects within karting, Australian motorsport and international opportunities.
