Background

There seems to be some confusion as to what is and is not approved by KA for number panels used on karts. So as to remove the confusion the following clarification is provided.

Extracts Of Rules

Competition Rules Chapter 1 Rules 11 e) and f)

In Competition Rules Chapter 1 Rules 11 e) and 11 f) the requirements for the size, spacing and background of the Competition Numbers are prescribed.

It states in these rules that the background colour must to be continuous and that there is a minimum of 15mm spacing between each digit.

The overriding provision contained in Rulle 11 b) that the <u>competition numbers must be clearly legible</u> at all times during a meeting (save for any incidental damage or tyre marking during a race that may render a number difficult to read) is the most important issue.

Examples of permitted numbers

For the sake of absolute clarity and the avoidance of doubt, the following examples of numbers that are permitted to be used is provided. Note that this is not a definitive list of permitted numbers and backgrounds but simply provides examples of the style of numbers that are approved for use.

There is not a minimum of 15mm spacing between each digit
