CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- Eligibility is limited to drivers who are holders of a current A, B or C Grade KA licence or licence holders from a foreign ASN as per Competition Rules, Chapter 4, Rule 22.
- D Grade or provisional licence holders are not eligible to enter.
- Refusal or acceptance of entries is in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 17.
- The promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel any event as in accordance with the Rules.
- NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

MINIMUM ENTRIES (Competition Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 l)

If less than 6 genuine entries are received to constitute a Class by the listed close of entries then the Class will NOT be contested. All drivers whose entry is not accepted for any Class shall be notified as soon as possible and entry fee will be returned.

NOTICE BOARD ENTRY CONFIRMATION AT THE START OF THE RACE MEETING

In lieu of an administrative checking session, an Official Entry List including transponder numbers will be posted on the Official Notice Board the afternoon of 15/09/2023.

It is the responsibility of the Competitor to ensure that all information on the Official Entry List is correct. Any inaccuracies or discrepancies are required to be notified to the Chief Timekeeper no less than 60 minutes prior to the start of Practise for their respective Class.

All Competitors will be required to complete an electronic Scrutineering Format the time of entry through the KOMP

PRIZES:

Trophies will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of Competitions Rules, Chapter 5 Rule 4 u). This will take place in the canteen approximately 30 minutes after the completion of all racing.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

KART RETRIEVAL:

Pit Crew with trolleys will NOT be given access to the Track during Qualifying and Racing. Retrieval is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Track when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a **HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST** in accordance with the Rules.

Karts can be retrieved via access through the In/Out Grid only.

INSURANCE:

Has been effected for this Meeting in accordance with General Rules, Chapter 3 of the 2023 KA Manual.

SCRUTINEERING:

Scrutineering for this Meeting will be in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2023 KA Manual.

In accordance with the provisions of the Technical Rules, Chapter 6 of the 2023 KA Manual, each Kart shall have affixed to it a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark supplied for the Meeting. This signifies that the Driver has confirmed their entry for the Meeting and completed a Scrutineering Form relevant to the Entry.

As from 16/09/2023, the Grid Marshal / Scrutineers shall not allow any Kart that does not display a correct scrutineering sticker or identifying mark to Practice, Qualify or Race. Failure to comply will result in the Driver being excluded from the Meeting.

VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS - Recording Medium (SD Card) Procedures

- a) It is compulsory for all Competitors to fit a camera to their Kart in a working condition in accordance with Technical Rules Chapter 1 Rule 8 from the start of the first practice session at each Meeting. Failure to do so during practice will result in Disqualification of the Competitor from the next practice session. In the event of it being the final practice session of the day the Competitor will start from the rear of the grid in qualifying.
- b) A separate SD Card must be used for each Championship Class contested at a Meeting.
- c) Prior to the commencement of on-track activity on each day of a Round, the Recording Medium used in the camera fitted to a Kart must be completely cleared and reformatted.

No recorded vision on the Recording Medium may be deleted from the time that on-track activity has commenced on each day of a Meeting until 0700 hours the next day, without the prior written permission of the Stewards.



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OUR OFFICIALS
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FRONT FAIRING (Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 g) (iii):

The Front Fairing Fitment Rules Will Not be used at this Meeting.

ENGINE SEALING AND CHASSIS TAGGING:

Each engine and Chassis must be sealed and tagged in accordance with the provisions of Technical Rules, Chapter 6.

TIMING TRANSPONDER FITTING INSTRUCTIONS:

MYLAPS compatible transponders must be mounted in accordance with Technical Rules, Chapter 1 Rule 8 i)

Note: All Karts MUST have fitted and correctly charged and operating transponders for all sessions commencing 16/09/2023

VEHICLE / TRAILER ACCESS:

Vehicle and trailer access will only be permitted until 8 am Saturday 16 Sept 2023. All vehicles must have been removed from the pit area by that time.

SECURITY:

Security will be provided each night 6:00pm- 6.30am Thursday, Friday and Saturday night.

PIT ALLOCATION:

Pit Allocation will take place Thursday 14 Sept 9am-6pm, Friday 15 Sept 8 am-6pm, and Saturday 16 Sept 6.30-8am

CANTEEN:

Canteen services will be available: Friday 15 September 9am - 3pm Saturday 16 September 7am - 4pm Sunday 17 September 7am - close

FURTHER NOTES

Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.

No unlicenced driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.

No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards, bicycles and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the event.

The Club does have EFTPOS facilities available trackside.
